

Meeting Pip

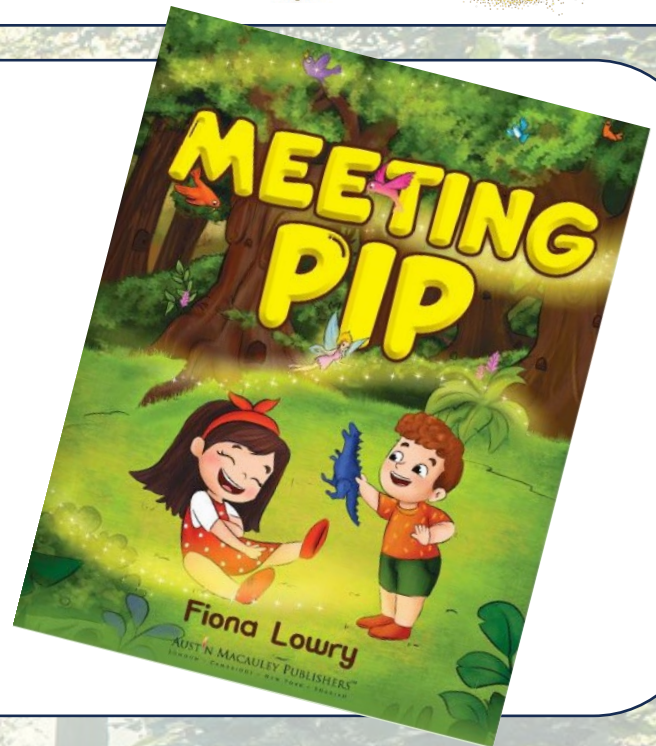
